SPEAKER	The speaker should complement the purpose of the gathering and the theme of the function.
BENEFICIARY	Who can apply? <p>The beneficiary applications are open to any registered charity located or specifically working within the LMCC LGA that has a demonstrated contribution to the welfare of the city. The beneficiary will be chosen by a committee of 6-8 representing Council, Church, Community and Student leaders.</p> Process: <p>Applications will be received online. Name websites, KW and LMCC Enews. Cut off dates will be 1 month prior to function. The chosen beneficiary will be notified 2 weeks prior to the function.</p> <p>The beneficiary will be announced at the function.</p> Who will choose the beneficiary? <p>The beneficiary will be chosen by a committee of 6-8 representing Council, Clergy and Community including student leaders (school captains).</p> Process for selection: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Applications received by members 2-3 days after close off date.• Committee to convene 3 weeks prior to function to discuss and decide.• Any conflicts of interest should be tabled prior to discussion and decision.• Committee to make beneficiary known to the Mayor's Office and function organising committee delegates.• Function Organising Committee to notify successful beneficiary on behalf of the Mayor and arrange necessary arrangements for the function.

FINANCE

The finance for the event to come under the due diligence of Kingdomworks INC9878178 ABN 26952386537. This entity was historically set up for city initiatives (ACTION). It has a Board, charity status and accounts are reviewed annually.

Event Finance Process

- Function to have a budget established by the Organising Committee that is submitted to the Kingdomworks Board.
- Organising committee to facilitate the event within the budget.
- KingdomWorks to ensure all bills are paid and beneficiary monies transferred in a timely manner.
